**MIDDLETON STREET CANAL BRIDGE, MIDDLETON STREET OVERFLOW BRIDGE,
BRAUNSTONE LANE EAST BRIDGE MAINTENANCE WORKS**

The Bridge structures named above require major maintenance works to renew parts of the bridge which are now in poor condition and require improvement. This will involve undertaking works to re-new the waterproofing system, road surfacing, re-pointing the brick abutments, up-dating parapets, installing new crash barriers and carry out concrete repairs under the bridge.

These works are part of this year's annual highway maintenance programme which is seeing £4.5m spent on road repairs, resurfacing and bridge maintenance across the city.

We plan to start works on Monday 28 September 2020, with works expected to last for a period of 14 weeks, subject to weather conditions and unforeseen site issues.

Advance warning signs will be erected at both approaches to the bridge, before commencing with works on site.

Pedestrian access will be maintained as far as is safely possible, however, there will be restrictions around the areas being worked on, especially during material deliveries and waste removal.

In addition, it may be necessary to impose temporary parking and loading restrictions along nearby roads and parking bays to facilitate traffic flows and material deliveries.

Access to Middleton Street either side of the bridge closure will be achieved via either Aylestone Road, Raw Dykes Road, Upperton Road, Narborough Road, Middleton Street/Braunstone Lane East, but there will be no through traffic access over the bridges.
