TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

LUBBESTHORPE BRIDLE ROAD/ENDERBY ROAD, LUBBESTHORPE & WATERGATE LANE, BRAUNSTON

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above locations.

A road closure is required at the below locations commencing on the 9th October 2020 for 18 months.

Lubbesthorpe Bridle Road – From its junction with Enderby Lane to the junction with Watergate Lane.

Enderby Lane – From its junction with Lubbesthorpe Bridle Road to where it meets Footpath W3a.

Watergate Lane - From where it meets Lubbesthorpe Bridle Road to the junction with Lubbesthorpe Road.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for Mather Jamie acting on behalf of The Trustees of ERB Drummond (deceased) and their appointed contractors to undertake associated development works, utility connections and various highway maintenance works.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via: Watergate Lane, Narborough Road South, Lubbesthorpe Way, Braunstone; Meridan Way, Tay Road, Beggars Lane, Lubbesthorpe and vice versa.
