

## To reach the Civic Centre

### From Leicester by Bus

Arriva Bus No 104 from Leicester City Centre.

### From Leicester by Car

Leave the City by the A46 (Leicester/Coventry Road) at the commencement of the dual carriageway take the **right hand lane** to the traffic lights. Cross over into the **right hand service road**. Kingsway is the 8th turning on the **Right**.

### From Leicester via A46 or M1

At the M1 access roundabout, take the west service road. Kingsway is the 3rd turning on the **Left**.

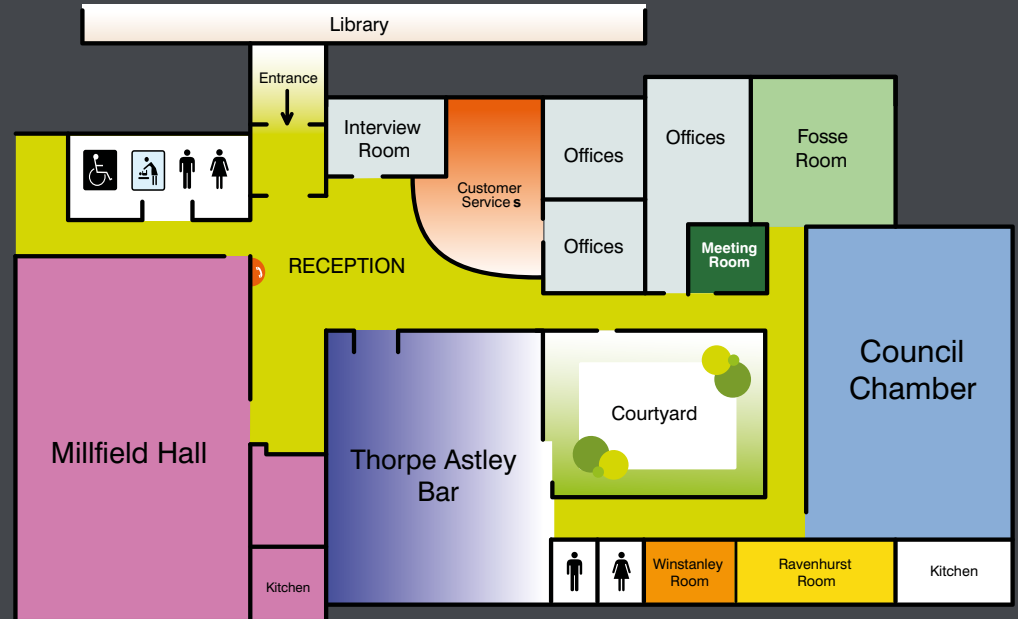

The **Civic Centre**, Braunstone, is a modern building completed in 1984 and extensively refurbished in 1997. The premises offer attractive accommodation, for both recreational and commercial purposes in the following form:



## Council Chamber

Available for smaller family events, conference meetings etc. The room is fitted with air extraction, coloured mood lighting and has a wooden floor.

## Millfield Hall

Millfield Hall is a large hall available for events and family parties. There is a large stage with stage lighting. Extension blocks for the stage are available. The Millfield Hall is fully air-conditioned. Variable coloured mood lighting can be set to your requirements.

## Committee Rooms

A selection of rooms are available for meetings or social occasions for smaller groups. All rooms are fully carpeted, curtained and fitted with fans. The Ravenhurst and Winstanley Rooms can be used as one large room or two smaller rooms.

The Civic Centre is licensed for music, singing and dancing, a theatre licence may be obtained by prior arrangement.

The Bar can also be opened before 7.00pm by prior arrangement. Hirers of our function rooms can now request that the Licensed Bar remains open until 11.30pm on Friday and Saturday evenings.

The Bar is now also open at lunchtimes Monday to Friday from 12.00noon – 2.00pm if you want to meet up with friends and enjoy a cup of tea or coffee with fresh filled roll or a homemade slice of cake.
